the book was born from the imaginative stories that Carroll used to tell to a girl named Alice it is the story of a journey made by a girl in a world of logical absurdities and paradoxes, Wonderland, where she meets strange characters

nonsense literature:

absurdity in language and situations that often create a sense of the uncanny

combination of childlike naivety and dreamy atmosphere coming of age:

Alice's adventure is like a symbolic journey from childhood to adulthood
